STATEMENT OF INTENT

TRANSGRESSIVE BEHAVIOR

For sports, study and student associations and other student organizations.





PREFACE

With this declaration of intent, the student well-being working group wants to ensure that the student associations of Delft give a joint message to stand up for the welfare of all students in Delft. There is an increasing awareness of mental problems among students. Research by I&O Research & Amnesty International on the topic of 'Studenten over verkrachting' showed that 11% of female students and 1% of male students are raped during their time as a student. Also, in November 2021, the research 'Monitor Mentale gezondheid en Middelengebruik Studenten hoger onderwijs' of the Trimbos Institute, the RIVM and GGD GHOR Nederland was published. This showed that 51% of the students experience psychological complaints (such as anxiety and gloom), of which 12% to a serious degree. 26% indicated that they have had the thought of rather being dead sometimes. Several student associations and organizations are addressing issues of mental health and sexually transgressive behaviour. Nevertheless, these topics remain in the background and are often not talked about openly.

Partly because of this, problems remain unaddressed and the right help cannot be provided. Increasing the ability to talk about this topic, is therefore of great importance. A structural approach is needed to prevent transgressive behaviour. By living up to the points in this declaration of intent, the associations and organizations will create an environment where every student feels safe and where everyone is aware of the problems that can occur during student life.

Signing this statement of intent means that the association expresses its intention to work for the well-being of its members and to work on one or more of the points below. This way we try to contribute to the social safety of students, ensuring that student life becomes and remains a time for learning, fun and self-development.

By signing this declaration of intent, the association promises to commit itself to one or more of the following points in order to counteract transgressive behavior, improve the well-being of its members and guarantee social safety within the association

Each association organizes an annual event that focuses on the topic.

This can be during the KMT but also at another time of the year. The association is free to do this whenever they want to, but it is recommended to do this as early in the year as possible.

Active efforts are being made to make the subject of transgressive behavior more open to discussion.

Besides the annual event, it is important that everyone is aware of the subject. A protocol and communication by the association can help members with this awareness.

Each association clearly communicates to his/her members where they can reach out to in need of help.

There are several possibilities for this. It can be short-term attention through flyers or by pointing it out during an introduction period, but also long-term communication by naming it in member's e-mails or on the website.

Each association has internal independent confidential contact persons who have attended appropriate training courses.

These are members who have taken a course from TU, LKvV or another organization.

Each association has a protocol for severe situations.

This protocol includes a timeline, who will be involved and what steps should be taken. A sample protocol is available from the VeRa.






